

A GLORIOUS JOURNEY: The **Domestic and Commemorative** Timepieces after the founding

The year marks the 100th anniversary of the founding of the Communist Party of China (CPC). To celebrate this milestone. Macau Timepiece Museum has designed a large countdown timer based on a domestic clock made in 1971, which enables Macao residents and visitors to recall the glorious paths and moments of the CPC over the past one hundred years. The Museum has also co-organised the exhibition "A Glorious Journey: The Domestic and Commemorative Timepieces after the Founding of PRC" with Chen Rui Xiang Skill-master Workshop in Wenzhou. More than 50 commemorative timepieces - including desk clocks, wall clocks, alarm clocks, pocket watches, aviation clocks and watches have been selected to bear witness to the hardships and spirit of modern China's construction. They carry the craftsmen's strong attachment to the homeland from the 1950s to the present.

The Macau Timepiece Museum comprises two floors, with four permanent exhibition areas - Contemporary Watches, Panerai, Antique Clocks and Antique Pocket Watches, and an interactive area. Visitors can appreciate timepieces from all around the world and learn about the history of Macao timepieces

The interviews present the life on the set from the perspective of a female director and share their experience behind the screen.
