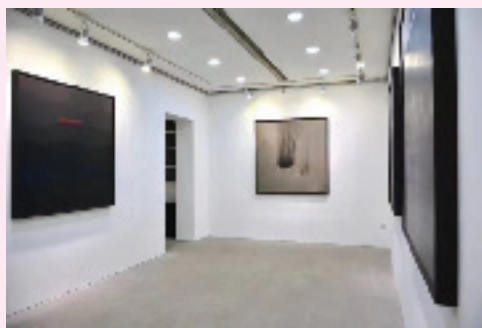


Profound - Works by David Sheekwan
